Overview

In this activity Participants give information to a receiver (peer) in a role play situation in a one- or two-minute scenario.

Participants seek and give feedback through a communication checklist.

Suggested topics for the one- or two-minute verbal presentations include:

- Describe your bedroom and its contents and how that relates to you as a person
- Describe your best moment in sport
- Describe your wallet contents and how they relate to you.
